



Indigo Fair 2026 | Performer Information Pack

Thank you for your interest in performing at the Indigo Fair 2026.

Indigo Fair is a vibrant community celebration that showcases the creativity, diversity, and spirit of our school and wider community. We welcome expressions of interest from school-aged performers, community groups, cultural performers, musicians, dancers, choirs, bands, and entertainers.

To ensure a safe, inclusive, and well-coordinated event for all participants and attendees, please carefully review the following information before applying.

1. The Selection Process

To help us curate a balanced and high-energy program, all prospective performers (individuals and groups) must submit a *3-minute audition video* to eventsfundraising@isspandc.org.au

Purpose: This allows our entertainment committee to assess stage requirements, sound needs, and age-appropriateness.

Format: A simple smartphone video or a link to a previous performance (YouTube/Vimeo) is sufficient.

Deadline: 11:59pm Sunday 5th July.

2. Performance Guidelines

Duration: Performances are strictly limited to a *maximum of 5 minutes*. This ensures the program remains fast-paced and allows us to showcase as many talented participants as possible.

Content: All performances must be "G-Rated" and family-friendly. This includes lyrics, costumes, and choreography.

3. Insurance & External Performers

By applying to perform at the Indigo Fair 2026, you agree to the following:

Safety & Conduct: Performers must follow the directions of the Stage Manager and Event Coordinators at all times.

External (non-school) groups or organisations are required to provide:

- a current Public Liability Insurance Certificate of Currency

- relevant child safety documentation where applicable e.g. Working with Children Blue Card.

The Indigo Fair Committee reserves the right to decline participation if appropriate documentation is not provided.

4. Media Consent & Photography

The Indigo Fair is a public community event where photography and videography may occur. By participating, performers and their responsible supervisor acknowledge that photographs and video recordings may be used by:

- Indooroopilly State School P&C Association
- Indooroopilly State School Indigo Fair
- Approved media or promotional channels, including school newsletters, social media, websites, future promotional material.

Parents/guardians should advise the Entertainment Team prior to the event if there are specific media restrictions relating to a performer by emailing eventsfundraising@isspandc.org.au.

5. Child Safety & Supervision Requirements

Indooroopilly State School P&C Association is committed to providing a safe environment for all children and young people attending the event.

Parent / Guardian Supervision

All performers under 18 years of age must:

- have parent/guardian consent to participate
- remain under the supervision of a parent, guardian, teacher, or responsible adult at all times unless formally managed by an approved school group or organisation

Blue Card Requirements

Queensland Blue Card requirements apply in accordance with Queensland legislation.

Please note:

- Parents supervising their own children generally do not require a Blue Card.
- External organisations or adults engaged in child-related activities are required to hold a valid Blue Card.
- The Indigo Fair Committee reserves the right to request Blue Card details or organisational child safety documentation where appropriate.

Performer Welfare

Any behaviour that compromises the safety, wellbeing, or comfort of children, performers, volunteers, or attendees may result in immediate removal from the event.

Non-School Performers Disclaimer: Performers who are not current students or staff are guests of the P&C Association. The Association reserves the right to cancel a performance at any time if conduct or

content is deemed inconsistent with Indooroopilly State School values - Honest, Optimistic, Nurturing, Organised, Understanding and Respectful.

6. Logistics & "On the Day" Instructions

Check-In: Please arrive at the **Entertainment Check-In Desk** located near the main stage at least **30 minutes** prior to your scheduled stage time. Late arrivals may result in performance cancellation.

Music: All backing tracks must be provided

- on a USB drive
- MP3/MP4 format
- clearly labeled with your name/group. Please also have a backup copy available on a phone or tablet.

Stage and Sound equipment on the day: To assist performers in planning their performance, Indigo Fair 2026 will provide a professionally managed outdoor stage and sound system.

Stage Specifications

The main performance stage will include:

- Mobile trailer stage measuring approximately 6 metres wide x 4 metres deep
- Stage skirting
- Professional front-of-house audio system
- Stage monitoring for performers
- Side PA wings
- Dedicated sound engineer and stage support crew

Please note: Performance groups must ensure their performance can be accommodated within the available stage footprint. Large props, scenery or equipment must be declared in advance on the Performer Expression of Interest Form. Please also indicate any accessibility or support requirements.

Stage access is limited to performers and authorised event personnel only.

Storage: There is no secure storage for instruments or personal items. Please keep your belongings with you or with a designated guardian.

7. Safety, Risk & Event Compliance

Props & Equipment:

Performers are responsible for bringing, setting up, and removing their own props.

The stage must be cleared immediately following your performance.

For safety reasons:

- no dangerous props or equipment are permitted
- no flames, pyrotechnics, smoke effects, aerosols, or hazardous materials are allowed

- no glitter, confetti, hay, sand, or liquid-based stage materials are permitted

Weather & Operational Changes

As an outdoor community event:

- schedules may change due to weather, safety concerns, operational requirements, or technical issues
- the P&C reserves the right to alter or cancel performances where necessary

8. How to Apply

Please complete the **Indigo Fair Performer Expression of Interest Form** and upload your 3-minute audition video by the deadline.

Note: Submission of an EOI does not guarantee selection. Successful applicants will receive a "**Final Stage Pass**" via email with their exact performance time and a site map one week prior to the event.
